# 1915 - Treasure's Report

- John V presented treasure's report
  - Gross Income to date \$\$44,343 (44% of yearly budget)
  - o Revenue on Budget
  - o Dinner revenue not holding. Discussion of increasing ticket prices for Dinner
  - Revenue from Annual Golf outing will make or break
  - Expenses on Budget.

# • SST Scholarships -

- John V. presented summary report on SST. Final scholarship amount is \$249K (82 Scholarships)
- o Approx. \$5,800 excess which will go to 2019 SST Scholarships
- Admiral discussed substantial increase in cost of SST due to fuel, food, and staff wages
- Discussion on how to get the work out that cruise costs more so more donations are needed

# • Meeting with Merrill Lynch

 John V, Jesse D, and Ted M – had meet and greet with Merrill as part of plan to explore alternatives to Fiduciary Trust

Discussion of dinner costs and possibly increasing ticket price to generate more \$\$

# 1935 - Membership Committee

- Discussion of need to simplify renewal process and to separate dues from donations
- Target date of June 11 to simplify sign up
- Website Tune-up/Modernization of website is in progress by an alum Annemarie found who is doing the work pro bono

#### 1945 - Assistant Director Search

- Dan, Saira, Ted and John V interviewed two candidates Ruth Merrill and Suzette DiCecco.
   Discussion followed of each candidate's strengths and weaknesses.
  - o Merrill was seen as the stronger candidate for a future *Director's* position if needed
  - DiCecco was thought to be a better fit for our current need of an Assistant Director.
     Also DiCecco lives in the Throgs Neck area.

# 1955 – Motion to offer Suzette DiCecco position as Assistant Director at \$20/hr. for 20 hours/week with 6 month probationary period (Mike T/ John V 2<sup>nd</sup>). Vote – Motion Passed
