# News from the College President

**April 18 Likely RADM Alfultis' Final MCAA Board Meeting:** We THANK YOU for your 10 years of heartfelt service, Sir!

**External Regiment Review**: The Admiral cited extensive review and interaction since February 2022 by staff and cadet leadership. 20 initiatives acted upon, 6 more identified for Fall 2024 by cadets. Campus Update to be issued May 1, 2024. MCAA asked that work/results be shared with Maritime College community so progress is understood.

SST Funding: \$2.3mm for fuel – fully Federally-funded! NROTC Strategic Sealift Midshipman Program (SSMP) funding doubled to \$64k in 2024. Petitioning NY State Senate to retain \$4mm allocation for SST.

**Enrollment and retention:** 400 students on campus for Accepted Student's Day on Saturday April 20th. Enrollment numbers are rising, both freshmen and returning students have been restored to pre-COVID levels.
