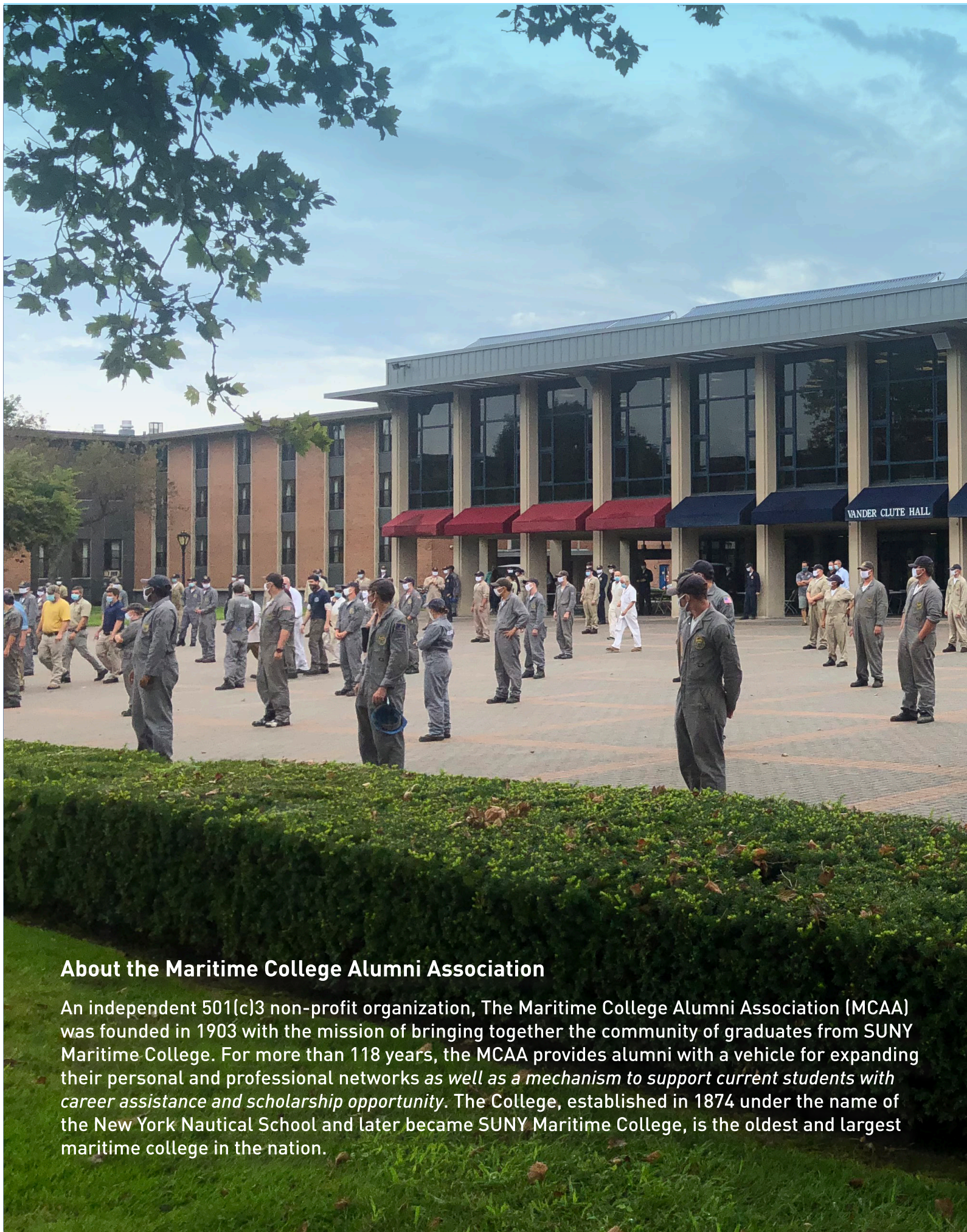

Greetings!

Thanks to the dedicated efforts of our Alumni Association, Board, staff, college administration, along with the enthusiastic participation of you, our members; MCAA continues to strengthen the connection that binds our graduates together. It is through your support that we are building upon traditions dating back to 1903. This past year, 2020, has been one like no other! Reflecting back, we are reminded of the wonderful spirit and good will throughout our community. We experienced increased involvement from alumni during a difficult time, which encouraged classmates to re-connect with each other. How wonderful!

We present to you this 2020 Annual Report to recognize the association's achievements over the past year and the numerous donors that have supported us during this difficult time.

Our fiscal year began with our Annual Awards Dinner where we came together to honor three outstanding Alumni; **Bart Kelleher '96**, **Bill Trenkle '80** and **Gary Jobson '73**. The event was a resounding success! Unfortunately, the pandemic forced us to cancel most of our other in-person social events and adapt to Virtual events where practical.

We saw the transition of our "New-Alumni Night" in-person event into a "New Alumni Virtual Mentoring" sessions, allowing Deck and Engine students on the verge of graduating to meet virtually with Alumni working in their respective fields.

As Alumni we see the value of shipboard experience and the importance of well deserving students having the opportunity to complete their studies with the essential hands-on experience. Although the Covid-19 pandemic prevented the college and students from embarking on 2020 Summer Sea Term, we continued to maintain our support to the adapted "Pier-Side Training" which took place last summer. Through arrangements with the U.S. Coast Guard, the college organized a 30-day Pier-Side Training program which would allow students to gain sea-time credit toward their license eligibility. The Board of Directors conducted a thorough review of the financial funds to determine what monies could be available for this effort. As a result, 21 participants received a financial award to cover more than 50% of tuition costs. In addition, all remaining participants, over 180 students, received a financial award of 25% tuition!

We continue to support the students with other scholarships such as the Charles Balancia '56 award and the Inaugural Class of '67 Academic and Sallyport awards, and the Class of '46 Tomb Lecture Series. The Class of '65 SST Scholarship giving is being enhanced for 2021, and new class funds and memorial funds are being initiated and added to our portfolio.

The summer Annual Golf Classic, our major fundraising event, was cancelled out of an abundance of caution, but we were able to host the fall Ancient Mariner golf outing, where we were fortunate to receive a full capacity participation!

CORPORATE PURPOSE

The purposes of the Corporation, in addition to and consistent with those set forth in the Certificate of Incorporation, include:

- Promoting **CAMARADERIE** among the alumni
- Providing a forum in which all alumni can network and enhance their **PROFESSIONAL GROWTH**
- Advancing the professional interests of the alumni and the Maritime College at **FORT SCHUYLER COMMUNITY** at large.

Even though we were unable to physically come together for a traditional on-campus Homecoming in 2020, we were able to host a series of pre-recorded videos prior to conducting our **LIVE** Annual Meeting – presented from our Alumni Association office on campus! We are working with the College on plans to host the 2021 Homecoming in person, in the hopes that the current health crisis subsides and state guidelines allow.

Increased efforts were made, and continue, for improving communications and transparency to you, our members. A re-configured web-site was rolled out with more user-friendly features and dedicated pages for Chapters to post. Board of Director Meetings went virtual, along with the issuance of video recap summaries. Board members have been posting videos on our Social Media pages to bring some insight into Board activities.

Membership dues, donations and member participation help us flourish. Membership fees and event revenue cover the operating expenses that keep the organization running. They allow us to offer a full schedule of quality events and help to us enhance our efforts to share opportunities for alumni and students alike.

Your continued commitment and participation at member-wide events, affiliation with local chapters and ongoing support of the Underway Fund will all contribute to the Association's growth. Simply put, we are depending on your membership renewal and active engagement to help us soar in the future!

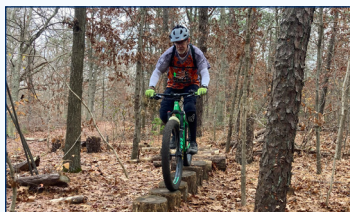

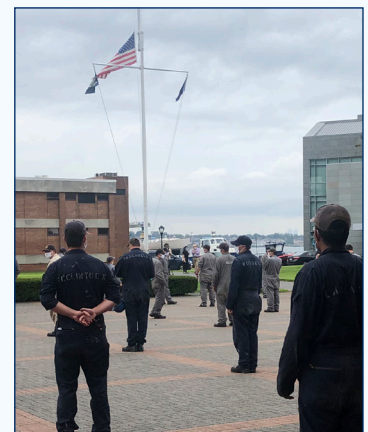

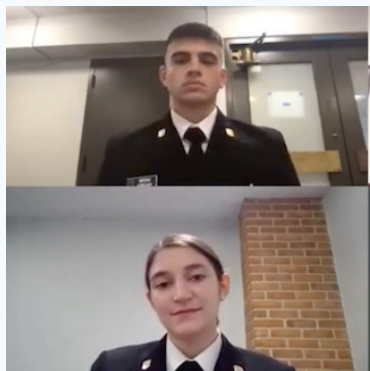

TREASURER'S ANNUAL REPORT

December 31, 2020

Greetings, Fellow Alumni!

My name is Kevin Comerford, Class of 1983, and I am the Treasurer of the Maritime College Alumni Association. I am pleased to bring to you, the membership, the Maritime College Alumni Association's Annual Treasurer's Report.

This Treasurer's Report summarizes the MCAA's financial situation in fiscal year 2020. We have seen very mixed results in our financial situation this past year. The stock market continues to thrive, and our funds are growing with it, but due to the worldwide pandemic our revenues have stalled and our expenses have not.

- The Annual Awards Dinner on January 30th was our first event of the year. We made a profit of \$57,000.
- Our largest fundraiser, the Spring Golf Classic, did not take place. In 2019 our net income from this event was just over \$80,000. In 2020 it was \$0.00.
- Spring and Fall Networking events did not take place. Homecoming at the college was cancelled, and the 2021 Annual Awards Dinner has also been cancelled.
- We hosted our Ancient Mariner golf outing on October 15th. Our net profit for this event was \$6,595.
- Gross revenue in 2020 is 67% below budget.
- Our monthly operating expenses are approximately \$9,000 per month. This includes salaries and rent. In 2021, the rent number will be eliminated but the salary number will be increasing.
- **The MCAA Net Income for 2020 is a loss of \$25,447.**

Below are the highlights of our Scholarship Funds that are residing at Fiduciary Trust International:

- The balance of the MCAA Funds at the start of 2020 was **\$9,852,335**. At the end of 2020 the balance was **\$11,746,195**. The value of the FTI funds increased **\$1,893,860** in 2020. This increase does not include the **\$120,000** the MCAA donated to the cadets taking part in the Pier-Side training program.
- Before the pandemic took hold, the MCAA had our portfolios positioned with a bias towards technology and growth oriented sectors. These sectors outperformed the broader market significantly.
- Performance broadened out in the 4th quarter as the 'pandemic hit' stocks started to recover.
- **Overall, the Funds ended up +21% for the year beating the S&P 500** while still maintaining an overall asset mix of 75% Equity / 25% fixed income and cash.

In 2020, the MCAA distributed a total of **\$120,000** to cadets to help defray the costs of the Pier-Side Training Program. Cost of the Pier-Side training program was **\$2,000 per student**. **184 students received \$500 scholarships** towards this cost and **28 students who showed financial hardship were awarded \$1,000 scholarships**. Since the training ship did not go to sea, the scholarships dedicated to **Chief Edward Pflieger** and **Captain William Sembler '52** (\$10,556 in-state and \$11,430 in-region) were not awarded in 2020. Careful scrutiny had to go into the Pier-side program scholarships as some of the MOU's specifically state the interest and dividends from their fund must go towards the SST program, which the Pier-Side training was not. After reviewing all the MOU's, 24 funds specified their interest and dividends should go towards 'scholarships' and not specifically the SST Program. This scholarship money is largely the result of the generosity of our Alumni Association membership.

Other scholarships awarded in 2020 include:

- **Class of October '46 Tomb Speaker Series** (\$5,000).
- **Class of '67 Sallyport scholarship**, two \$500 awards (\$1,000 total).
- **Charles Balancia Scholarship** given to an incoming 4th Class Engineering Cadet, two at \$1,000 each (\$2,000 total).
- **Class of '67 academic scholarship**, two cadets \$2,250 each for the Fall semester (\$4,500 total).

Since 2004, the Maritime College Alumni Association has donated over **\$3,305,444** to the students and Maritime College combined.

In December of 2019, the MCAA merged seven funds into a new fund called the **Seven Fund**. We had 35 funds and, because of administrative reasons, have been trying to reduce that number. The seven funds all had identical MOU's and we found there was no advantage to keeping the funds independent as they all follow the same investment policy and the money can be better and more efficiently managed by Fiduciary Trust and the MCAA Bookkeeper by merging the funds into one fund. All seven funds were Restricted and the new Seven Fund is also Restricted.

The **Seven Fund** gains and/or losses will be recorded at the end of every year using the percentages each fund contributed to build the new fund. This will allow the contributors of each fund to always know how their fund is performing. Should any additional money be added to any of the seven funds, the percentages will be changed to reflect the addition.

The **Alumni House** fund was terminated and the monies were deposited into the Valiant Fund. Both the Alumni House Fund and the Valiant Fund are Unrestricted. The reasons for doing this are the same as for the Seven Fund, administrative and efficiency.

The organization did apply for and received the Small Business Administration loan through the **Paycheck Protection Program**. The MCAA received \$16,231 in May of 2020. In January of 2021, this 'loan' was forgiven as part of the Federal Government stimulus package.

Membership Dues numbers have shown a drop in calendar year 2020. As compared to 2019, the MCAA membership dues totals are down 29%. If you have paid your dues, thank you for your continued membership. If you haven't yet paid your dues, I hope you will consider doing so in the future. Your support is needed for our

Alumni Association to continue to thrive. If you have not attended a recent event or have not paid your dues in a while, please considering doing so. If you know a fellow Alum who is not a member, encourage them to attend an event with you. Although we have re-established a working relationship with the college, and have a permanent office back on college, there are over 15 years of graduating classes who do not know who we are. The Alumni Association has a long road ahead of us to regain the stature we had in the 70's and the 80's.

The **independent auditor Condon O'Meara McGinty and Donnelly LLP** audited our financial records from 2020 and expressed that our books are in good order. The auditor considered our internal controls to the extent they believe necessary to determine and conduct the audit to render an opinion. They found no significant deficiencies or material weaknesses during their audit, and there were no adjustments made, a trend we are committed to continuing. Our internal controls ensure transactions are authorized, executed and recorded properly.

Bookkeeping duties are performed by Verma Associates. Kamal Verma has been doing the MCAA bookkeeping since 2011 and is very dedicated to the organization.

The consolidated financial statements in this report accurately reflect the organization's financial position, results of operations and workflows. The financial information is prepared in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) in the United States. The financial statements in this document are the complete set presented to our auditors. I have reviewed them, and to the best of my knowledge, they contain no untrue material statements nor do they omit any material facts.

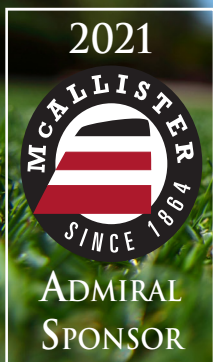
